Lake Tahoe Luncheon- Monday May 4, 2009

A tour to Lake Tahoe is truly one of the most beautiful destinations in the world. The lake is surrounded by the dramatic Sierra Nevada Mountains and thousands of acres of National Forests. The bus will journey through high mountain passes before dropping down to the lakes basin.



Once you arrive at the marina, we will board a replica of a historic paddlewheel boat. When on board and underway, much of the two-hour cruise is narrated and you will hear some of the colorful stories about life around the lake in times past. A plated lunch is included.

A Day in Virginia City-Tuesday May 5, 2009 As we ascend into the foothills via the deluxe

As we ascend into the foothills via the deluxe motor coach, the exciting history of Virginia

City, and how this boomtown came to life will be revealed.

Built on the riches of gold and silver ore, Virginia City was not only known as "the richest place on earth", but was also the biggest city between San Francisco and St. Louis in the 1860's. Abounding with 30,000 people and 110 saloons, it was an affluent and rowdy population. Today, Virginia City stands as a link to the past- a town vibrant with the activities of visitors, and filled with memories and ghosts of days gone by.

Our personal guide will escort us through the downtown, telling many legends of "rags to riches" and "riches to rags".

There are beautiful Victorian mansions, mines, wooden sidewalks, original saloons, gambling halls, antique shops, museums and churches to visit. You can tour the town on foot or board the trolley to see the sites.

Included on this tour is a 35 minute narrated train ride on the Virginia & Truckee RR from Virginia City to Gold Hill and back. Going right through the most famous of the bonanza Comstock mines.
